- 1 Students selecting Mathematics as the Secondary Teaching Field take MATH 270 and 301 and fulfill Secondary Teaching Area electives with requirements listed on the back. Others take MATH 105 and a 3-hour elective (MATH 201, 206, 210, or STAT 214).
- 2 19 credits must be earned in a Secondary Teaching Area.
- 3 9 hours of science, which must include at least 3 hours of Biology and 3 hours of CHEM, GEOL, or PHYS. Six of the 9 hours must be in the same science; credit cannot be awarded for both GEOL 225 and GEOL 105.
- 4 Spanish Electives: Select 18 credits of SPANISH courses at the 4xx level.

- 6 Select from EDCI 463 (Foreign Language Methods) or EDCI 448 (English Methods)
